<p>AGES AND GRADES</p>	<p>11U/6<sup>th</sup> Grade and Under 14U/9<sup>th</sup> Grade and Under</p>
<p>REPORT TIMES</p>	<p>11U/6<sup>th</sup> reports at 6:15 pm – 7:30 pm 14U/9<sup>th</sup> reports at 7:30 pm – 8:45 pm</p>
<p>TEAMS</p>	<p>Each week a TeamX staff person or volunteer will divide up sticks randomly. Teams will be tweaked each week to ensure competitive balance. Once players are separated sports pinnies will be distributed</p>
<p>EQUIPMENT</p>	<p><u>Required:</u> Street Hockey or equivalent Helmet with cage, hockey stick, shin guards TeamX Summer Sports t-shirt <u>Recommended:</u> Hockey gloves, elbow and knee pads</p>
<p>PLAYING TIME</p>	<p>1 hour running clock</p>
<p>SUBSTITUTIONS</p>	<p>Numbering system with changes controlled by a central clock</p>
<p>PENALTIES</p>	<p>Standard NHL penalties will apply. (please see CONDUCT section for additional rules)</p>
<p>OFFSIDES</p>	<p>Enforced for both age groups</p>
<p>ICING</p>	<p>Enforced for both age groups</p>
<p>CONDUCT</p>	<p>All coaches, players, parents and volunteers are expected to model high character behavior at all times. A player who receives 3 penalties will be ejected for the evening. Players, coaches, parents may at no time argue with referees. Profanity, trash talking verbal intimidation will not be tolerated. Lead referee will determine appropriate discipline Fighting will result in a four week suspension. An interview with the League organizer will be required before being admitted back into the program. Excessive physical play will result in game suspension Players are expected to shake hands at the conclusion of each game</p>
<p>RESPONSIBILITIES</p>	<p>Please be respectful of the park and pick up all trash. Players will be asked to clean up the entire playing area before leaving the rink</p>

NHL Section 6 – (TeamX Modified). Section 6 rules of the NHL pertain to physical rule violations. These rules are the most severe types of penalties that could cause player injury. Therefore, the consequences for violating these rules are more severe when playing TeamX Deck Hockey

Section 6 – Physical Fouls	Penalties
<u>Rule 41 - Boarding</u>	1 <sup>st</sup> Offense - 30 minute Major 2 <sup>nd</sup> Offense - Match Penalty and One game suspension
<u>Rule 42 - Charging</u>	1 <sup>st</sup> Offense - 30 minute Major 2 <sup>nd</sup> Offense - Match Penalty
<u>Rule 43 - Checking from Behind</u>	1 <sup>st</sup> Offense - 30 minute Major 2 <sup>nd</sup> Offense - Match Penalty and One game suspension
<u>Rule 44- Clipping</u>	1 <sup>st</sup> Offense - 30 minute Major 2 <sup>nd</sup> Offense - Match Penalty
<input type="checkbox"/> <u>Rule 45 - Elbowing</u>	1 <sup>st</sup> Offense - 30 minute Major 2 <sup>nd</sup> Offense - Match Penalty
<input type="checkbox"/> <u>Rule 46 - Fighting</u>	Match Penalty and Season Suspension, Player must have interview with League before readmission
<u>Rule 47 - Head-butting</u>	Match Penalty and 4 Game Suspension, Player must have interview with League before readmission
<u>Rule 48 - Illegal Check to the Head</u>	Match Penalty plus One game suspension
<u>Rule 49 - Kicking</u>	Match Penalty
<u>Rule 50 - Kneeing</u>	Match Penalty
<u>Rule 51 - Roughing</u>	1 <sup>st</sup> offense - 10 minute Major. 2 <sup>nd</sup> Offense - 30 minute Major 3 <sup>rd</sup> Offense – Match Penalty plus One game suspension
<u>Rule 52 - Slew-footing</u>	1 <sup>st</sup> Offense - 30 minute major. 2 <sup>nd</sup> Offense - Match Penalty
<u>Rule 53 - Throwing Equipment</u>	Match Penalty

Match Penalty – Player is removed for the duration of the game

All penalties are at the referee’s discretion. The Referee may adjust penalties depending on the severity of the foul
