

2020 Black Hills Winter Classic Adult Division Information

Information/ Eligibility

**** Note – Since this is the beginning of a new calendar year ALL players must complete a new USASA/SDASA insurance and receive a new 2020 player card.**

- A new player MUST be go on line to register as a USASA member/insured player, "[Click Here](#)" **You will see an option for the 3 day tournament available, please only use that one if you are just signing up for just a tournament pass only for \$25. When filling out information you will come to a box indicating DL that is your driver's license number (this is mandatory).

NOTE: If you plan on playing in any other tournament in 2020 it is cheaper to purchase the annual for \$45.

- Team captains MUST send a list of players that will be participating on their team to office@westriveradultsoccer.com so the Registrar can validate eligibility (List sent by email ONLY) - **This must be done by the stated deadline prior to the start of the tournament.**
- Captains, if you have players that need a card processed you MUST send a face forward head shot (jpeg) to office@westriveradultsoccer.com
- Rosters and player cards will be verified and approved at check-in and the Official Roster will be signed by the WRAS Registrar after validation is confirmed.
- Players must present their player card and government ID at check-in, players that do not have a player card will receive it at check-in after confirmation of SDASA membership/insurance, signing the roster/code of conduct and paying the \$10 fee.
- NO PHOTO, NO INSURANCE, NO CARD, NO PLAY, NO EXCEPTIONS
- All Players in Adult divisions will follow the hosting organizations and WRAS policies, procedures, code of conduct and guidelines.

Rosters/Age Eligibility - All Divisions, the age eligibility is 17 years and older

- The maximum number of players rostered is 10.
 - Men's Open – open to both genders, no requirement of females on the court
 - Coed Open – open to both genders, a requirement of 2 females on the court at all times or the team must play short in their absence.
 - Women's Open – open to Women only
 - NOTE: Any player that is 17 years of age must have a parent present to sign documents in addition to the player themselves.
- Roster changes may occur up and until 5:00 pm on the Monday prior to the first games of the tournament and ONLY by email to give the Registrar time to process card and validate eligibility, NO CHANGES after deadline.
- Player eligibility steps must be completed no later than 5:00 pm on the Wednesday before the start of the tournament, captains will be notified what is needed for their teams.

Team/Player Check - In

- ALL TEAMS/PLAYERS MUST CHECK-IN AND RECEIVE TO RECEIVE A WRIST BAND.
- Check in will be done at the headquarters The Monument (Rushmore Plaza Civic Center) Friday, Jan 17th from 4pm – 10pm, and again on Saturday from 9am – 11:00 am. **(Depending on final schedule, this is subject to change)**
- Teams/players may check in one hour prior to their first scheduled game, keep in mind the sooner the better, less congestion if you come early.

- Necessary items at check - in:
 - Signed Roster (all players must hand sign their legal signature on roster when checking in for Release of Photo/ Liability/Code of Conduct) – Toni will have at team check in.
 - Code of Conduct – Toni will have at team check in
 - Team Liability form – Toni will have at team check in
 - USASA current player card – Player card will be on site (if all steps are completed) at check in and pay the \$10 fee.
 - Valid government issued photo ID
