- 52% more likely to show improvement in school day attendance.
- 80% more likely to complete homework on time.
- 77% more likely to show improvement in school day behavior.
- 43% more likely to show improvement in math & reading scores.

99% of Boys & Girls Club of Brazoria County members promoted to the next grade.
