

Millville Soccer Association Hardship Scholarship Application

Millville Soccer Association may grant registration fee scholarships to children who without this financial assistance would not be able to participate in one of Millville Soccer's programs. The Millville Soccer Association Hardship Scholarship program focuses on providing opportunities for area youth to participate in Recreational and Travel soccer because of the physical, mental and character training benefits these programs can provide. Hardship scholarships are only available to cover the cost of registration for Recreation or Travel teams and are not available for any additional costs (uniforms, equipment, tournaments, etc.).

Scholarship requests must be submitted to the Millville Soccer Association no later than January 1st (for consideration for the Spring Season) and July 1st (for consideration for the Fall Season). Hardship scholarships will not be awarded until the last week of the registration period. The Registration Committee will consider all complete applications received by the application deadline. The amount of the hardship scholarship awarded (if any) may be partial or full registration fee depending on the number of applicants and amount of funds available. Hardship scholarships are awarded one season per registrant. Therefore, individuals must reapply for each season they are requesting assistance.

Millville Soccer Association is a non-profit organization with a very limited amount of funding available for the Hardship Scholarship. No guarantee of assistance is implied with this application. If the number of applications submitted and approved exceeds the amount available, the scholarships may be awarded by a lottery system.

Requirements for eligibility:

- Athlete must be age appropriate for Millville Soccer's programs and be a city resident.
- Commitment to attend a minimum of 90% of scheduled practices and games.
- Participation of an adult family member in at least 10 hours of voluntary service to Millville Soccer Association before the sponsored season (after approval) or during the season.
- Application must be completed by a parent, guardian, or head of household, with ALL requested information provided. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Consideration will be given to eligible applicants meeting one or more of the criteria below. The more information you can provide to us, the better able we will be able to determine the hardship.

- Receiving assistance from other programs, such as Food Stamps, WIC, foster care, etc (Must provide written documentation).
- Written recommendation by school representatives, social workers, community workers or other social service representatives.
- Documentation demonstrating an immediate financial hardship.

Millville Soccer Association does not discriminate based on gender, race, class, economic status, ethnicity, sexual orientation, physical ability or religious backgrounds.

Please Note: Approval of a Hardship Scholarship does not register the participant. You must still register the player for the desired season.
