The manager is responsible for the execution of the functions necessary to run a successful team and a teacher of baseball skills. He is accountable to the RAH-Boys Baseball Board, responsible for his players while on the field, and dedicated to communicate with the parents throughout the season.

Manager's Responsibilities include:

- Obey and enforce all RAH, Travel, and Boys Baseball by-laws (as amended), and league rules that apply to your team
- Assist in pre-season work-outs and/or drafts for the in-house Boys Baseball program
- Attend any coaches clinics that are provided through Boys Baseball
- Complete financial accountability for assigned team in accordance with RAH and Boys Baseball guidelines. No exceptions to this policy.
- ALL FINANCES need to be run through RAH and the RAH Treasurer. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Treat all players in a fair and equitable manner
- Demonstrate good sportsmanship, self-control and proper behavior at all times
- Ensure the good sportsmanship and proper behavior of team players and assistant coaches
- Attend all assigned league baseball meetings
- Teach the players to have fun and enjoy the competition of travel baseball
- Assure that all players receive playing time
- Help the players develop a healthy, competitive attitude toward winning and losing
- Assess individual player's strengths and weaknesses and create a development plan to help each player improve in the areas of concern
- Encourage and compliment players: use constructive criticism
- Attend a minimum of 90% of their team's games and practices
- Support other travel teams whenever possible

Manager's Rights:

- To be treated with respect by players, parents and umpires
- To be made fully aware of the rules and policies under which they must function
- To have access to necessary safety equipment and practice fields
- To expect full cooperation from parents when asked to assist
