***Expectations and Responsibilities***

- Follow Burlington Township Recreation Commission Policies.
- Attend the BTSCA quarterly meetings and/or send a substitute.
- Respect and care for the programs equipment and fields, and inform the Recreation Department if equipment is lost or stolen or if fields are damaged.
- Contact each child on his/her roster. Hold a team meeting to open communications with the parents. Coaches should explain their goals and objectives for the team, as well as the rules of the league and policies of Burlington Township Recreation.
- Recruit a Team Parent. Team parent communicates activities such as Sports Club fundraisers, camps, tournaments, etc., to the team’s families.
- Remain after practice until all players have been claimed. Advise parents of canceled practices and/or games.
- Travel players shall play in accordance with the guidelines established in the “Travel Soccer Policies and Player Development”.
- Being a coach means, first and foremost being a teacher. Coaches will teach players skills, techniques and strategies. Players will be given the opportunity to improve their skills, gain confidence and develop self-esteem. Coaches will teach in a positive, supportive manner.
- Enforce and practice good sportsmanship by all players, coaches, and parents.
- Respect officials and their judgment and abide by the rules of the event.
- Pay fines the league assesses against the coach.
- Support the Burlington Township Memorial Soccer Tournament.
- Submit the TIPSS player ratings forms within 30 days of the completion of each season.
