

JUNIOR DEPUTY BABE RUTH LEAGUE FALL SEASON SUPPLEMENTAL RULES

These rules are to be used as a supplement during the Fall Season. For any situation not covered below, the “Babe Ruth League Rules”, dated March, 2015 and the Official Babe Ruth, Inc. Rules will be followed.

1. Managers are required to submit their final roster to the Commissioner by September 7, 2019.
2. A player cannot participate in games without having completed his registration.
3. Any undrafted, registered player will be assigned to a team for the fall season.
4. Each game will be 90 minutes or seven innings of play, whichever comes first.
 - a. If time expires in the middle of an inning, the inning will continue until the home team takes the lead or the visiting team records the third out.
 - b. If time expires and either team is ahead by more than the run limit, then the game will end
 - c. If the game is tied at the end of seven innings or if the game is tied at the end of an inning after time has expired, the game will end in a tie.
5. After the conclusion of each game, the Home Manager must submit the final score to the Commissioner.
6. With two outs, a courtesy runner(s) is permitted for the pitcher and/or catcher of record. The player who made the last out is to be used as the courtesy runner.
 - a. “of record”: Ex. In the top of the 1st, the starting pitcher or starting catcher.
 - b. “of record”: Ex. In any other inning, pitcher or catcher who manned the position during the previous half inning.
7. All games will have a five-run limit per inning. The reduced run limit is intended to speed the pace of play and increase the number of innings in order to maximize batting and fielding repetitions.
8. Round robin batting is mandatory.
9. Free substitutions are allowed during the game.
10. Pitchers
 - a. Any 13-year-old or 14-year-old pitcher is allowed to record up to six outs per game.
 - b. A 15-year-old pitcher or a combination of two 15-year-old pitchers can record up to six outs per game. No more than two 15-year-old players can pitch in the same game.
11. A Manager is limited to one mound visit per pitcher per inning. A second visit to a pitcher in the same inning will warrant a pitcher change.
12. Once a pitcher leaves a game, he cannot return to pitch in the same game or pitch in any other game that day.
13. To facilitate having an adequate lineup for each game, Managers may borrow/loan one (1) player for the purposes of pitching or catching. The Commissioner will not mediate these negotiations.
14. Mondays are designated for makeup games.
