



Saint Vrain FC Air Quality Policy

The Saint Vrain FC air quality policy will serve as a guide for coaches and players regarding unsafe training and/or match conditions related to air quality. Saint Vrain FC will utilize the national standards for air quality as established by the Environmental Protection Agency. Those standards can be found at airnow.gov, as well as in the table below.

- Training and matches will continue at all times when the AQI is in the 0 - 100 range.
- Training and matches may be canceled for players under 10 when the AQI is over 100.
- Training and matches will be canceled for all ages when the AQI is 150 or higher.

Air Quality Index Levels of Health Concern	Numerical Value	Meaning
Good	0 - 50	Air quality is considered satisfactory and pollution poses little or no risk.
Moderate	51 - 100	Air quality is acceptable; however, for some pollutants there may be moderate health concern for a very small number of people who are unusually sensitive to air pollution.
Unhealthy for Sensitive Groups	101 - 150	Members of sensitive groups may experience health effects. The general public is not likely to be affected.
Unhealthy	151 - 200	Everyone may begin to experience health effects; members of sensitive groups may experience more serious health effects.
Very Unhealthy	201 - 300	Health alert: everyone may experience more serious health effects
Hazardous	301 - 500	Health warnings of emergency conditions. The entire population is more likely to be affected.

- If a player chooses not to attend training or a match when the AQI is 100 or higher, that decision will not negatively affect the player's standing within their team in any way.
