FREDERICKSBURG, Va. (Thursday, March 19)—We wanted to follow up our previous press release with an update during this time of uncertainty. We will continue to look for guidance from the local government, school systems, leagues and US Soccer. Unfortunately, at this time we will need to push the start-up date for our Spring 2020 programming until March 27. Other counties in our area have recently updated their start dates to begin April 14. We believe these start up dates will carry over to Spotsylvania and Fredericksburg soon enough. If so, FFC will adjust and update you at that time.

The leagues FFC teams compete in are also working diligently through this time to try and work out adjusted arrangements once the COVID-19 (coronavirus) related suspension of activities has ended.

In regard to FFC programming at this time, any Spring registrations for Academy, Pre-Academy, Minis and/or Recreation will be credited for future club programming if there are any further cancellations carrying over into April and May.

At this moment, we have only experienced our regular scheduled school Spring Break week off and our first official 'no training' week will begin this upcoming Monday, March 23.

The club will be holding weekly virtual board and coaches' meetings to keep discussions going and provide up-to-date information on all the possibilities and concerns which may affect the club, players and families.
