

Player/Parent Code of Conduct

Players and parents/guardians are required to sign this Player/Parent Code of Conduct form.

Abusive or foul language and unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated by players, managers, coaches or any adult during games or practices. Such behavior can result in actions ranging from expulsion from games or practices to permanent expulsion from the complex. No warning is necessary.

Players:

While participating in organized JOBL activities, both on and off the field, players are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that represents a positive attitude, good sportsmanship and respect toward authority. Swearing, disrespect or misuse of equipment will not be tolerated.

Players are expected to put forth 100% effort at practices and games. Negative attitudes contrary to productive efforts, as well as displays of disrespect towards staff members or other players, could result in removal from participation in practices and/or games as well as possible removal from the team.

Team Rules and Commitment - PLAYERS

- ❖ Players are to treat other players, coaches, fans and officials with respect at all times.
- ❖ Players cannot leave the dugout without permission from the Manager/Coach during practices or games.
- ❖ Players, Manager and Coaches only allowed in dugouts during practices and games.
- ❖ No cell phones allowed on field during practices or games.
- ❖ No eating in the dugouts during practices or games.
- ❖ No friends in the dugouts or on the fields during practices or games.
- ❖ Players must be on time for all practices and be dressed appropriately.
- ❖ Players will be expected to bring all their equipment to practice and games.

Attendance:

- ❖ Players must attend all practices.
- ❖ Missing practices can result in not starting or playing in the next game.
- ❖ Players must contact their Manager prior to missing any games or practices.
- ❖ Players are expected to be on time for practices.
- ❖ Players will be expected to be in attendance at and participate in all team activities.
- ❖ No friends in the dugouts or on the fields during practices or games.

Parents and Guardians:

JOBL realizes that at times, a parent or guardian may not agree with a coach's strategy, method of discipline or coaching technique. Parents should also realize that coaches are human and mistakes can and will be made. Parents/guardians must discuss their concerns with the coaching staff *after the end of a game, but not at any time during play. Verbal or personal attacks against any staff member or player will not be tolerated at any time.* Any discussions are to be held in the presence of the entire coaching staff. JOBL expects that its parents and guardians assist in creating a positive atmosphere for their child and the entire team.

Team Rules and Commitment – PARENTS/GUARDIANS

- ❖ Parents will be responsible for their child's behavior on and off the field.
 - ❖ Parents NOT ALLOWED in the dugout during practices and games.
 - ❖ Parents are NOT ALLOWED to coach from the stands.
 - ❖ Parents NOT ALLOWED on the field during practices or games, unless invited by manager.
 - ❖ Abusive language and unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated by players or adults.
 - ❖ Parent/guardian will be on time to pick their child up upon conclusion of games or practices.
 - ❖ Verbal attacks directed at any staff member or player at any time can result in disciplinary actions ranging from temporary exclusion to permanent exclusion from the complex.
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- ❖ Any parent found to be involved in any illegal activity or who unlawfully possesses, es, sells or is under the influence of a controlled substance while on the JOBL complex, including, but not limited to, illegal drugs, tobacco and alcohol can be removed from the complex.

Violations of any part of this Code of Conduct by a player, parent or guardian may result in the immediate removal or suspension of a player from the team.

With our acceptance of the Code of Conduct online I/we indicate that I/we have read, understand and agree to the policies and procedures of this Code of Conduct that sets forth JOBL's expectations of its team members and their parents/guardians, whether the parent/guardian be a parent, manager or coach of a team.
