

Team Georgia Wrestling

Registration steps

Parents,

The following steps are necessary for ensuring your child is correctly registered for a USA Wrestling membership and TrackWrestling account for the 2013-14 Folkstyle Season. Please read them carefully as the information you provide will ensure that Team Georgia has the most correct information when bracketing the state tournaments.

1. Go to <https://www.teamgeorgiawrestling.com> & click on the Membership tag, choose the correct option to purchase a membership.
 - a. If you are RENEWING you must have last year's card number (Failure to use the same number will affect your child's Trackwrestling data!!!)
 - b. Ensure your child's name and club are the same and correct
2. When you have completed the USA Membership, you will need to go to www.TrackWrestling.com There you will need to sign up for a basic free account (You may choose to acquire a paid Gold account to better track and filter other wrestlers and how your child compares to them).
 - a. If you had an account previously you will need to verify it
 - b. Please list the same club as you chose for USA Card to make sure team points are properly assigned at State
 - c. Keep your TrackWrestling ID with your USA Membership Card number. There are some National Tournaments that you register for through the TrackWrestling system.
3. Check your TrackWrestling account often.
 - a. Check your win/ loss record
 - b. Check your child's rating
 - i. It will be used in building the State Brackets
 - ii. For best results check one weight up and down from the one you wrestle
 - c. If there are conflicts use the following order of corrective steps: (this must be done with in 7 days of the end of the tournament.)

- i. email Tournament director to have results verified
 - ii. email the competition committee at results@teamgeorgiawrestling.com
 - d. Most issues will need to be addressed by the tournament staff. They are responsible for entering the correct data to track wrestling the day after the event. They are required to make all changes for the next 7 days after that event. If you contact them after this time, your change will most likely not occur.
 - e. At the events verify the bout sheets are correct at the end of matches. This is where most issues will be found and can be corrected easily.
4. Occasionally your wrestler will not be linked to an event they attend or will attach to an event that your wrestler did not attend. This happens when 2 wrestlers have similar names.
- a. You can remove an event that is not your wrestler or attach an event that did not attach automatically.
 - b. Falsifying this data, adding events that are not your wrestlers or removing events that your wrestler participated in could bring disciplinary action on the wrestler, parent or coach.
