



COVID-19 RETURN TO PLAY GUIDELINES AND PROTOCOLS FOR GBL GAMES

BASEBALL & SOFTBALL

ARRIVAL TO VENUE

- All participants, spectators, and employees must adhere to six-foot physical distancing while at the facility.
- Must conduct daily symptom assessments by coaches and players (self-evaluation). Anyone experiencing symptoms must stay home.*
- Fields will be limited to 50% Capacity.
- All events will have staggered start times so arrivals and departures will be different.
- Players, Coaches and family members can not enter the park more than 30 minutes prior to their scheduled start.
- Please use the designated entrance at Cameron Brown based on your child's age division.

SPECTATOR GUIDELINES AND PROTOCOLS

- Must adhere to six-foot social distancing practices off the field of play.
- Concession stands will remain closed.
- Families and players are suggested to bring their own food and beverage.
- Game times will be scheduled so age divisions arrive and leave at different times.
- Due to per field capacity limitations, only a player's immediate household family members will be allowed to attend games,
- Siblings will be allowed to attend games but will have to remain within immediate distance of their parent/guardian and not allowed to roam.
- Spectators will be required to bring their own chairs. Bleachers will not be accessible.
- Each field will be clearly marked to assist spectators adhere to the six-foot social distancing practices.
- Spectators must not enter field areas or areas designated for players.
- Must keep six-feet or more distance from the backstop.
- It is strongly recommended that spectators wear face coverings at all times.
- Hand washing or hand sanitizing, in the absence of soap and water, is recommended strongly during the games.
- Hand sanitizer will be available at every field complex.
- Water fountains must remain closed.
- Restroom occupancy will be limited.
- Restrooms will be sanitized on a regular basis.
- No more than 2 games will be taking place at the same time at a field complex.
- Teams/families must leave the facility no more than 15 minutes following the conclusion of the game.
- No bikes, scooters or skateboards we be allowed at games

* Per the CDC, symptoms include cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fever, chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headaches, sore throat, and new loss of taste or smell.

ATHLETE/GAME GUIDELINES AND PROTOCOLS

- **Must adhere to six-foot social distancing practices off the field of play.**
- Each dugout will have hand sanitizer for players and coaches
- A bottle of disinfectant will be in each dugout for disinfecting any areas or equipment
- All dugouts will be sanitized before and after games
- All communal areas will be disinfected on a regular basis
- Only 3 to 4 players allowed at a time in dugouts with social distancing being maintained. An area will be designated for players not on the field to safely social distance.
- The catching position will be eliminated in Tball, JrCP or Coach Pitch.
- Home plate umpires will stand a safe distance behind the pitcher in all kid pitch divisions 12U and down. It will be umpire preference in 14U and 18U.
- Only one umpire per field (14U and 18U will have two umpires)
- No infield player meetings during the game.
- Coaches may visit a pitcher and conduct a meeting with proper distance being maintained.
- No pre-game coach/umpire meetings
- No In-game/postgame handshakes, player high 5's, fist bumps, etc.
- If any personal equipment is shared it must be disinfected before next use
- Team water coolers will not be allowed. Each player must have their own labeled water bottle.
- For Games at Cameron Brown specific instructions will be communicated on which gate to enter and leave based on their division.
- Players, coaches and families will not be allowed to enter park more than 30 minutes prior to their scheduled game.
- Coaches must wear a mask outside the field of play and in the parking lot.
- Coaches and players on the field will have the option of wearing masks. **The wearing of masks by players while on the field is not recommended**
