



## Red Land Youth Baseball Manager Expectations

First, I want to thank you for volunteering your time to coach and mentor the youth of our community. It's becoming more and more difficult to find people willing to do so and we are very thankful for your commitment.

I wanted to go over the requirements needed to manage with Red Land Youth Baseball, yes it takes more than a willing person.

### Background Checks

Probably the most important thing you will do. Yes it's time consuming, but VERY necessary and it's the law. Basically we require a State Police Clearance, Child Abuse History Clearance and either a signed affidavit (*PA resident for last 10 years*) OR FBI Fingerprint-based History Check (*Not a PA resident for the last 10 years*). ### First Aid and Coaches Training

We are switching to online-based training. In the past we would hold clinics for First Aid and Coaching, that would get very little attendance. We are hoping that with something that you can do at home at your own pace would be easier. USA Baseball has what they called their "Baseball ACE" Certification. There are currently three, A, B and C. We are requiring all Managers at a minimum to pass the Baseball ACE A Certification. If you want to take B, by all means, but it is not required. Also, would not hurt to have your assistants take the A Certification either, but at this time it is not mandatory.
