

**Nampa Valley Little League
2017 All-Star Commitment Letter**

Dear Player and Parents:

Each player who wishes to be considered to be on a NVLL All-Star team is required to fill out and turn in a **signed commitment letter the day of tryouts**. Only players who have filled out a commitment letter will be allowed to tryout. All-Star teams will be selected by the NVLL board, based on the tryouts after the **All-Star Assessments on May 31, 2017 at 6:30 pm at Birch Fields**. The All-Star teams will be posted on the NVLL website on June 2, 2017.

If selected as a member of the All-Star team, you will represent Nampa Valley Little League in competition against other area teams for the title of District 2 Champion. **All-Star season duration: June 8th until possibly mid-August**. (Depending on how far the team advances).

In signing this commitment letter, you and your child agree that your child will attend at least 80% of practices, 100% of games and put forth their best effort. Absences are allowed for illness and family emergency and by Manager Discretion. Parents should ensure that their child arrives at all practices and games on time. All-Star teams are highly competitive and winning games is the primary objective. Tournament minimum play rules apply during Little League sanctioned events.

This year all All-Star players will be required to pay **\$100.00** for their uniform and participation in tournament. Parents need to be aware there will be additional costs during the All-Star season.

2017 Little League All-Star Tournament Dates: These are tentative dates that are due to change.

- July 6-9th District 2 All-Star Tournament
- July 14-16th Idaho State Tournament
- Aug.3-6th Regional Tournament

There usually are additional tournaments that all-star teams play in before the District 2 Tournament.
