METROPOLITAN DC-VIRGINIA SOCCER ASSOCIATION (MDCVSA)
Tournament Hosting Agreement

In consideration of being granted permission to host a tournament/games we hereby agree to:

- 1. ABIDE BY THE RULES. We shall abide by all statements made in our Application to Host a Tournament or Games, in our tournament invitation, in our tournament rules and in the MDCVSA Hosting Agreement. We agree that all decisions regarding acceptance of teams into a tournament shall be fairly and impartially made and shall not be based upon race, creed, color or national origin.
2. REQUIRING MEDICAL AUTHORIZATION. We shall require teams and/or players under the age of 18 to provide notarized medical authorizations in a form adequate for use at the site of the tournament. These authorizations shall be presented to the Host Organization at registration and kept at the field available for use by the team.
3. ADVANCE PUBLICATION OF RULES. We agree that our tournament rules shall be published and distributed to all teams accepted, prior to the start of the tournament.
4. CREDENTIALS CHECKS. We agree that we shall conduct credentials checks at tournament registration and prior to each match to ensure that all players are registered with US Adult Soccer or approved organizations, properly rostered with their team, and participating in accordance with representation set forth on the Application to Host a Tournament or Games
5. USE OF USSF REGISTERED REFEREES. We agree that we shall, in accordance with USSF Rule 3040, use only USSF registered referees, who are in good standing, for all tournament games, and shall utilize a one or three referee system. There will be an adequate number of USSF registered referees available in the area during the tournament dates to cover the scheduled tournament games. We have selected the following Assignor to assign referees for the tournament games:
6. USE OF SPECTATOR LINES. We agree to take appropriate steps including, where feasible, the use of spectator lines on each field to keep the spectators off the touch line.
7. PROVISION OF ADEQUATE TOURNAMENT COMMUNICATION. We agree to provide adequate communication by means of between the game fields and the tournament headquarters. The Tournament Communications Director is:
8. AVAILABILITY OF POLICE AND RESCUE SERVICES. We have notified the local police, ambulance and emergency rescue services of the date(s) of the tournament and the times and fields which will be used for games, and have been advised by them that they will be available to render assistance if needed.
9. TOURNAMENT CANCELLATION. We agree that our tournament rules shall state what refunds, if any, shall be made to participating teams if all or a portion of the tournament is canceled by the host organization for any reason
10. TOURNAMENT RULES – BEHAVIOR. We agree that our tournament rules contain provisions ensuring that the behavior of teams, players, coaches and spectators are appropriately controlled including specific provisions which spell out the disciplinary measures to be imposed for the issuance of red and yellow cards or other improper conduct; which indicate what procedures will be followed regarding protests and appeals; which indicate that all disciplinary measures imposed by host organizations shall be limited to placing restrictions upon an individual's group participation in the tournament; which states the issuance of all yellow and red cards and other matters involving the conduct of a team, its players, coaches or supporters will be recorded by the host organization and also reported immediately to the home state association and the home club/league except that all matters involving referee assault (or abuse) shall, in accordance with USSF Rule 3041, be referred immediately to the home state association; and which state that the home state association and the home club/league shall, except in the case of referee assault, have the responsibility for imposing, should circumstances warrant, additional sanctions within their respective jurisdictions with regard to any matters arising from the tournament.
11. POST TOURNAMENT REPORT. We agree that we shall file a Tournament Report with the MDCVSA granting us permission to host this tournament, within thirty (120?) days after the conclusion of the tournament. We understand that failure to file the report shall preclude the tournament host from receiving sanction for any tournament for the following seasonal years until the report is filed.
