



Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct:

- Ⓢ I hereby pledge to provide positive support and encouragement for my child and his/her team by following the PVYB Code of Conduct.
- Ⓢ I will ensure that my child attends every practice and game on time and I will inform my child's coach when he/she is unable to attend.
- Ⓢ I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, and officials at every game, practice, or other PVYB events.
- Ⓢ I will refrain from using profanities, yelling, speaking disrespectfully, or showing any form of aggression toward coaches, umpires, other parents, spectators, or players.
- Ⓢ I will respect the official's decision and will refrain from showing disapproval.
- Ⓢ I will place the emotional and physical well-being of my child ahead of a personal desire to win and will remember that the game is for youth and not for adults.
- Ⓢ I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free of drugs and alcohol, and will refrain from their use at all PVYB events.
- Ⓢ I will not smoke or use tobacco products on the field or in the bench area during practice or games.
- Ⓢ I will treat other players, coaches, spectators, and officials with respect regardless of race, gender, creed, or ability.
- Ⓢ I will be present at all practices and games unless prior arrangements have been made.
- Ⓢ Under no circumstances will I instruct, or shout instructions to my child during the game. If I think it is necessary to assist my child in certain aspects of the game, I will wait until after the game is over.
- Ⓢ I will not approach my child's coach with issues or concerns during or immediately after a game.
- Ⓢ I understand that the coaches are trying to put my child in positions that fit their physical abilities, and I acknowledge that the coaches can be more objective about my child than I can. If I think it is necessary to discuss with the coaches my child playing a different position, I will share my thoughts in private and in a calm manner.
- Ⓢ I will wait 24 hours after an incident before discussing coaching issues and concerns with my child's coach.
- Ⓢ I will seek to resolve issues with my child's coach in as constructive a manner as possible and will consider the best interest of all the persons involved. If unable to resolve issues by working directly with my child's coach, I agree to work with Kevin Zynn (475-6503) or Jason Civitello (970-7027)

Consequences of noncompliance to the Parent Code Conduct:

First Offense – Verbal warning

Second Offense – Parent must leave the premises.

Third Offense – Meeting with coach, parent(s) and board member.

Fourth Offense – Dismissal of player without refund
