



Player Code of Conduct:

- Ⓢ I will attend every practice and game on time and will notify the coach if I cannot.
- Ⓢ I will give maximum effort at all times on the field by running out all hits, sliding on close plays, and hustling to back up my teammates.
- Ⓢ I will always run onto and off of the baseball field
- Ⓢ I will never sit down on the baseball field
- Ⓢ I understand the coaches are doing what they think is best for the team and so I will not ask to play a specific position during a game.
- Ⓢ I understand that making outs, striking out, and making errors are part of baseball. Therefore, I will not cry, pout, stomp my feet, or have negative body language if I strike out, make an out, or make an error.
- Ⓢ I will never throw my glove, helmet or other equipment.
- Ⓢ I will encourage good sportsmanship from fellow players, coaches, officials, and parents at every game, practice, or other PVYB event by demonstrating good sportsmanship.
- Ⓢ I will refrain from using profanities, yelling, speaking disrespectfully or showing any form of aggression toward coaches, umpires, parents, spectators, or other players.
- Ⓢ I will respect the official's decision and will refrain from showing disagreement by throwing of gloves, helmets, hats, bats, balls, or any other forceful unsportsmanlike action.
- Ⓢ I will do my very best to listen and learn from my coaches.
- Ⓢ I will treat other players, coaches, spectators, and officials with respect regardless of race, gender, creed, or ability and I will expect to be treated accordingly.
- Ⓢ I deserve to play in an environment that is free of drugs and alcohol and expect adults to refrain from their use at all PVYB events.
- Ⓢ I deserve to play in an environment that is free of tobacco products on the field or in the bench area during practice or games and expect adults to refrain from their use in those areas.
- Ⓢ I will remember that participating in sports is an opportunity to learn and have fun.
- Ⓢ I will refrain from using unnecessarily rough tactics against the body of an opposing player.
- Ⓢ I will remain on the bench and be attentive when my team is batting.
- Ⓢ I will only swing a bat when it is my turn at bat. If I am on deck I may warm up only if my coach allows me and only in the designated area.
- Ⓢ I will clean up trash around the bench and spectator areas after each game.

Consequences of noncompliance to the Player Code Conduct:

First Offense – Verbal warning

Second Offense – Player will sit out of practice or game.

Third Offense – Meeting with coach, player, parent(s) and board member.

Fourth Offense – Dismissal of player without refund
