II APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

On a motion made by Tara, seconded by Jim, the minutes from February 21, 2016 were approved with all members in favor.

III TREASURER'S REPORT:

On a motion made by Jim, seconded by Tara, the Treasurer's Report was approved with all members in favor.

IV COMMISSIONERS' REPORTS:

Soccer:

- Caramba Camp will be the 1st week in August. Jen has contacted past players.

Baseball/T-ball:

- Suncook Valley League will decide if there will be a 2 hour time limit for Minor games – Meeting is March 24th.
- Assessments will be March 22nd, all 5th and 6th graders will be asked to attend.
- The Board requested the playoffs to be held in Chichester.

Softball:

- 1 major team, 1 rookie team.
- Prior to the meeting, Doug requested that softball and baseball switch fields every other year. Issues with the upper field - sun, no power for pitching machine, batting cage is on lower field, parents can't see game if working the snack shack.) There was discussion of purchasing a portable mound to have the lower field shared. Tabled for next year.

Snack Shack:

- Joe M. suggested to shut the power down on June 30th to save money. Possibly coordinate with the town for billing.
- Need to be stocked by the first game.
- Brianne stated that she could do a google drive document to have parents sign up for home game snack shack coverage.
- Tammy stated that she believes that lower field is responsible for covering the snack shack.

V EQUIPMENT MANAGER’S REPORT:

- Tara suggested a new lock for the shed as everyone knows the combination. It's important that the coaches know this. We have not had any theft. We will keep the lock for this year.
- Need Lime (order at Clarks)
- Fire department offered to help with first aid/CPR, they will go to the field and train up to 20 people.
