### I ATTENDANCE:

### II APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

On a motion made by Jim Chiavaras, seconded by Tammy Montambeault, the minutes from 1/19/11 were approved with all members in favor.

### III TREASURER'S REPORT:

**Checking Account:** \$23,298.94

**Savings Account:** \$6,160.43

- We are now using QuickBooks online for keeping track of the money.

### IV COMMISSIONERS' REPORTS:

**Soccer:** Should we do a soccer camp? MSA? Challenger? There is no financial obligation from the CYA. Jacqueline will look into the MSA soccer camp has it is more technical and skills based. A one-year contract will be signed.

**Baseball/Babe Ruth:**

- Chip Wagner needs \$500 is needed for insurance. Some changes coming for baseball – maximum of 6 runs per inning. Playoffs will go back to 10 batters per inning. Minors Tournament will be pulled from a hat to determine seating. Majors are determined by win/loss record. Suggest having both Minors and Majors pull from seating/record.
- Jim Chiavaras asked if there would be a skills assessment. Yes, a skills assessment will be done again. Looking into Concord Sports Center from them doing the assessment instead of the Coaches. A motion was made by Doreen Lehoullier to allow up to \$325 seeing what the assessment includes, seconded by Tammy Montambeault.
- T-ballers moving up to Rookies will still be covered under insurance.
- Chip Wagner will send an email to last year's players with the upcoming gym times.
- Umpire Chief will schedule the umpires. If for both baseball and softball, the board agrees with having an Umpire Chief.

**Softball:** Northwood dropped out of the league. Team count and money is due by March 31<sup>st</sup>. Estimated about 6 teams.

## **VI EQUIPMENT MANAGER'S REPORT:**

### **Baseball:**

- The batting cage needs the net replaced. Joe Montambeault made a motion to not exceed \$750 to replace the net (about \$550 for the net, \$120 for the hardware, and a pitcher's screen for free, if bought by the 15<sup>th</sup>.) Seconded by Chip Wagner. Discussion – Todd stated that this will be money well spent. Jim proposed to research the cost to have it installed. Doreen suggested having signs created to state “no climbing.” The Board was all in favor.
- The catcher's gear is in. Need a list of what is needed for the bags – enough equipment for practices by March 6<sup>th</sup>.

**Soccer:** Shawn Marston proposed have the CYA purchase 6 -12 pop up nets. Tammy Montambeault will research prices.

## **VII FUND RAISING:**

- The Valentines Dance on 2/12/11 was a success. Everyone had a great time. Mama Kicks and the Elks would like to do it again next year. Total profit made was \$2159. Will need new coordinators for this event next year.
