Soccer:

Baseball/T-ball:

- Registration Forms:
 - Discussion of age vs. grades – the levels will stay as age as the Cal Ripken Suncook Valley guidelines use age.
 - Assessments will occur again this year and will be used to evaluate teams within the same level and if kids are able to move up to the next level based on skill/number of teams/number on teams/safety/etc.
 - Parents need to sign up kids at the level for their age and based on assessments, the child could be moved up.
 - T-ball will be for children who are 5 prior to September 30th through age 7 as of April 30th.
 - Due date is February 29th

- Late registrations forms will be accepted until March 12th, including a \$10 late fee.
- A fee change was suggested and approved by the Board to change the fees for Rookies through Majors:
 - T-ball = \$25
 - Rookie – Majors = \$45
- Suggestion from the Board for only one person to be a Head Coach for one team.
