II APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

III TREASURER'S REPORT:

IV COMMISSIONERS' REPORTS:

Soccer:

- Soccer registration forms going home through school. Due date 7/19/15.
- Members present decided to go back to Maroon colored jerseys since there are so many other red teams in the league.
- Jacqueline attended a soccer league meeting and stated the concerns for their decision of no tournaments and requiring patched refs for the U8 level – there will be tournaments for U10 and U12 and a U8 jamboree. CYA is opting out of getting U8 patched refs.
- Jacqueline will request the largest tournament to host for soccer.
- Fields need to be measured – (1) U8/10 field on lower field, (1) U8/10 on new area, (1) U12 field on upper field.
- Lining of the soccer fields should only be done as necessary for games only. A lot of paint was used last year.

Baseball/T-ball:

- CYA is the only town that has 2 umpers for major games – will determine at the beginning of next season if still necessary.
