

ADASL Manager's Quick Reference Sheet

Welcome to the ADASL. The ADASL is the longest continuous running soccer league in the state of Georgia. The ADASL is a Sunday, competitive high quality adult soccer league. The league is chalked full of former elite college and foreign national players. To achieve success in the 18 game ADASL season, a team must maintain a full quality roster supported by an organized manager

- For your team to be accepted into ADASL for an upcoming season, the team must:
 - Pay the \$300 one time League Admin Fee for each new season.
 - Register at least 11 players into the ADASL player registration site and pay ADASL \$55.00 for each player registered.
 - Captains must upload a current quality head shot photo for the player ID to the Affinity site.
 - Pay the league first half ref fees in before the season starts and second half ref fees before the second half of the season starts. Ref fees for 2016-17 were \$900.00 a half.
 - Perrin Cup Tournament Fee is \$100.00
 - Secure a Home Field. Games can begin at 10 AM on artificial turf fields; 11 AM on grass. All games must conclude before dark.
 - Have at least 2 set of Kits (matching jersey with numbers; shorts & socks.) The Home team is required to not conflict with the Visiting Team.
- The Home Field's dimensions must fall within FIFA standards. The game officials are the sole judge of the quality of the lines, the goals, netting and corner flags. Home teams will suffer a forfeit if the officials rule the home field does not meet acceptable standards.
- ADASL does not have a relationship with the Georgia Soccer Park. ADASL can facilitate field rentals at this facility at \$150.00 a game.
- The ADASL season begins the first Sunday in October. All regular season games must be completed by the end of May. Rainouts/make up games single handedly determines the length of the season.
- Before and during the season:
 - Teams can register 25 players max on their active roster.
 - Teams can only dress 18 players max for a specific game
 - Teams can release and register new players up until the last month of the season. (The specific cutoff date is determined by the executive committee.)
 - New players must be registered prior to the day of the game. A successfully registered player is one that has been registered in the player registration website, with a quality head shot photo uploaded and payment processed through the Affinity site.
 - Released players can be re-registered as long as 10 days has passed for a \$10 a player fee.
 - Substitution Policy: A player who subs out during a half cannot return to play in the same half.(Players subbed out in the first half, can play in the second half)
