

LEAGUE POLICY GOVERNING TEMPORARY PASSES

Temporary passes are not intended to supplant the hard pass required by the By Laws whenever the hard pass is not available. They were intended only for temporary use during the period between the time a player was registered and the issuance of the hard pass. After the issuance of the hard pass, the player is only allowed to play with the hard pass, or with the permission of the appropriate League official on a temporary pass. The team managers are responsible for the management and control of their teams' passes.

Teams have implicit permission for using a temporary pass for **one week** after the player has been registered. Beyond that period explicit permission is required for the use of a temporary pass.

If the hard pass has not been received within one week of registration, the manager must contact the registrar to notify of the lack of pass and to request permission to use a temporary pass.

If the hard pass has been lost, the manager must contact the registrar to acquire a duplicate pass and to request permission to use a temporary pass until the duplicate is issued.

If a player is/was subject to disciplinary review and the hard pass has not been received from the League, permission from the D & P Chairman is required to play on a temporary pass.

The above constitute the only reasons and methods for the use of a temporary pass. Any other use of a temporary pass may subject the team to review and possible forfeiture of games in which a violation occurs.
