COACH'S CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Coaches will keep a scorebook with the full name and number of each player participating in the game, logging all substitutions and the inning they enter the game.
2. Managers, coaches, their assistants and their players will not direct abusive language, sarcasm or make demeaning remarks toward athletes on their own team, spectators, officials or other players and coaches. Managers are responsible for the behavior of their players regarding this rule. If the Board is notified of any behavior problems, Board members will observe the team and discuss the matter with the manager. The Board will take appropriate disciplinary action.
3. In the event that a regularly scheduled game is cancelled due to weather or field conditions, the makeup game will be played at a time approved by the North Side Board.
4. The use of tobacco / alcohol by managers, coaches or players at games, practices or any North Side function is not allowed. Managers will enforce this rule. Violation may result in disciplinary action.
5. Coaches will conduct regular, positive practices for all players. A written practice schedule encompassing at least two weeks at a time provided by the manager to each team member is encouraged.
6. All players will play at least three full innings and have at least one at bat each game they attend, providing they are in good standing with their attendance. In the event a game is shortened due to time limits or weather and a player is unable to get in three full innings, that player should start the next game to ensure he/she gets three full innings.
7. I understand Tournament Team manager and coaching positions are selected and approved by the North Side Baseball Board of Directors. Selection will be based upon, but not limited to: decorum on and off the field, knowledge of the game, rapport with the players, parents and other coaches, and the ability to make the time commitments necessary to follow the tournament trail.
8. I will make every attempt to maintain competitive parity among and between the other teams in the league at all times with the exception of the league tournament.
9. I will be responsible for the appropriate treatment and care of league equipment and facilities, and will make repairs to, or replace, any such articles damaged due to any action not considered "normal wear and tear."
10. I understand that my attendance at league meetings is mandatory and will make a considerable effort to attend all necessary functions as determined by the league President.
11. I understand that it is a privilege and not a right of any kind, to participate in the league and will conduct myself in accordance to the intent of the league at all times as described by Babe Ruth, Inc. and the North Side Baseball and Softball Board of Directors. I understand the league President, or members of the Board, have the authority to discipline, suspend, remove, or replace me at their discretion, and that there is no appeal process. I understand that this action may be taken at any time and is final.
