

Dynamo FC Girls Coaching Staff 2012-2013

Jimmy Carson- Dynamo FC Girls Technical Director

Jimmy currently holds a US Soccer National "B" License and NSCAA Goalkeeper Coaching Level 1 Certificate. He has coached at Dynamo FC since 1999, most recently serving as Girls Technical Director, and is an active board member. He has coached the Dynamo FC '95, '94 Girls, and, u19 Women. He also coached the Dynamo FC u23 and '87 men's teams. He has been an Indiana Olympic Development Program staff coach for six years and was Indiana State Select Women's Team coach for two years. He currently works for the Indiana Soccer as a coaching education instructor. Jimmy was the head soccer coach at North Central High School for three years. At North Central, he won three sectional titles, one regional championship and in 2006, he helped guide the panthers to the IHSAA state finals. Prior to taking over as head coach, Jimmy served as the women's assistant and goalkeeper coach for three years.

Jimmy received a BS in Elementary Education and a Masters in Administration from the University of Indianapolis and was a four year starter on their men's soccer team. He played his high school soccer at Lawrence North High School, earning All Conference and All District honors. In his playing career, he was also a member of Dynamo FC Katner '80 team, the Indiana Select team, and Indiana Olympic Development team.

Tim Blom

Tim Blom joined Dynamo FC in 2011. He has coached the Dynamo FC '02 Girls. Tim is a very talented coach and educator. He currently holds a US Soccer National "D" and will complete the US Soccer National "Youth" courses this summer. Tim is the former head women's soccer coach at North Central High School. Prior to moving to Indy, he was the head coach at Petal High School in Mississippi and University High School in West Virginia. In addition to coaching high school soccer, Tim has coached club soccer for the Hattiesburg Storm Girls (2 time Mississippi State Champions), West Virginia United Girls (3 time State Champions), and West Virginia United Boys (2 time State Champions.)

Tim attended Georgia Southern University and earned his degree in Secondary Education in 1999 and masters of Education in 2001. He was the Co-captain for two years and Team MVP in 1998. He was also the Georgia Southern Scholar Athlete of the Year in 1997 and 1998. Tim is the Co-Author of: *Survival Guide for Coaching Youth Soccer*. (Champaign, IL: Human Kinetics, 2009).

Emily Bowden

Emily will complete the US Soccer National "D" course this summer. She served as an assistant coach to Wes Preist and the boy's academy last spring.

Emily played her college soccer at Xavier University. Prior to Xavier, she earned First Team All-State, First Team All-District, NSCAA/adidas All-Region Team, Academic All-State Team, and Marion County Player of the Year honors while attending Brebuef Jesuit High School. Emily was a member of the Dynamo FC '90 team, which won the Indiana State Championship in 2006.

Cara Burchett

Cara joined the Dynamo FC staff in the fall of 2011 and has worked in our girl's academy. She will complete the US Soccer National "D" License and US Soccer National "Youth" courses this summer.

Cara is a graduate of Butler University where she played four years of Division I soccer. Prior to attending Butler University, she earned ICGSA All-State first team, ISCA All-District, Suburban East Honors Team; all-county honorable mention, Hoosierfutbol Top 60 Senior, ISCA Top Team Player, and IHSAA Role Model honored honors, and was a four year varsity letter winner at Warren Central High School. She helped her club team, the Carmel Crossfire, to the state championship in 2006.

Julie Burton

Julie currently holds a US Soccer National "E" License and she will complete the US Soccer National "D" course this summer. She has served as an age group assistant coach and an assistant goalkeeper coach during her time at Dynamo FC.

Julie is currently a member of the Butler Women's soccer team. Prior to her time at Butler, she was a three-year starter at North Central High School. Julie was a two-time second team all-state honoree, twice named ISCA Academic All-State, named academic all-conference three times, and tabbed second team all-district as a senior in 2009. She was also high honor roll student ranking in the top 25 in her graduating class. Julie played her club soccer for Dynamo 92 Red, helping the team to a pair of Indiana State Cup championships.

Troy Cockrum

Troy has been coaching youth soccer for 19 years. This will be his 3rd year with Dynamo. He currently holds a US Soccer National "B" License. He has coached all ages from U10 to U17, both boys and girls. He has coached teams for Dynamo FC, Carmel United, Cardinal Soccer Club (Cincinnati), Cincinnati Classics Hammer FC, SWISA and Evansville Premier. During this time, he has coached two teams that finished runner up in the Indiana State Cup and two teams that were Ohio South State Semi-finalists.

Troy received his BS from the University of Evansville and was a member of their men's soccer team. He also has a Masters from the University of Cincinnati and is currently a Middle School Language Arts teacher.

Jared Guy

Jared earned the University of Indianapolis' Kelso Reid Mental attitude award his senior year and earned over 38 starts in his two years with the Greyhounds, captaining the team his senior year.

Ric is also the current Butler women's soccer assistant coach and we at Dynamo are proud to have such an amazing educator of the game in our program. Ric currently holds a US Soccer National "D" license and NSCAA (National Soccer Coaches Association of America) Advanced National Diploma. Ric will complete the US Soccer National "Youth" course this July and the US Soccer National "B" course this winter.

A native of Bloomington, Ind., Ric brings with him collegiate and professional playing experience as a former member of the Indiana University men's soccer team and the Indiana Twisters of the Continental Indoor Soccer League. He also played on the 1998 National Indoor Championship team.

Jessica Hunt

Jessica currently holds a US Soccer National "D" License and a National Soccer Coaches Association of America (NSCAA) National Diploma. She will complete the US Soccer National "Youth" course this July. Jessica joined the club in the spring of 2012.

Before joining Dynamo FC, she was an Academy Trainer at Maumelle Soccer Club in Maumelle, AR and an administrator, coach, and trainer at Arkansas Soccer Club North Little Rock, AR. Jessica also started and directed a soccer program for the Arkansas School for the Deaf in Little Rock for three years. In 2008, she was awarded the Arkansas State Soccer Association Boys/Coed Coach of the Year. Jessica is a graduate of University of Arkansas at Little Rock Little Rock, AR.

She was rated as one of the top two goalkeepers in the state of Indiana by the ESPN RISE player rankings. Kristin played her club soccer for Dynamo 92 Red, helping the team to a pair of Indiana State Cup championships.

Gabi Ingram

Gabi just completed an outstanding four year playing career at Kent State University. She will complete the US Soccer National "D" License and US Soccer National "Youth" courses this summer. During her time at Kent State, she earned (3.46, biology/pre-med) started 74 games and was a key defender in aiding Kent State to post eight shutouts in 2011, which tied for second most in team history. Gabi also garnered NSCAA honorable mention Scholar All-Region and OCSA Academic All-Ohio honors.

Prior to college, she was a four year Academic All Conference member at North Central High School. While at NCHS, she was also named First Team All-State and also took home All-Region, All-County, All-District and ISCA All-Academic accolades. In 2007, she helped North Central to a regional championship after a state runner-up finish in 2006. Gabi was a member of the Dynamo FC '90 team, which won the Indiana State Championship in 2006.

Michael Lovett

Michael is originally from Murray, KY and begins his third year at Dynamo. In addition to his coaching responsibilities at Dynamo, he is currently the Director of Soccer-Plus Goalkeeping School and has helped organize & coach college soccer camps at Murray State, Ball State, Virginia Tech, Purdue University & Notre Dame. Prior to Dynamo, Michael was an Assistant Coach at Murray State University & Virginia Tech and most recently was the Head Women's Soccer Coach at Ball State University.

Michael holds a National Soccer Coaches Association of America (NSCAA) National Diploma, an NSCAA National Goalkeeping Diploma and a NSCAA National Youth Diploma. While playing, Michael played club soccer with the Bon-Air Thunder in Kentucky and his college soccer at the University of South Alabama. Post college, he was a goalkeeper for the Mobile Revelers, an United Soccer Leagues team based in Alabama in 1994.

Chad joined Dynamo FC in the spring of 2012. He currently holds a US Soccer National "B" License and has over 20 years of coaching at the youth, high school, and collegiate level. Chad has spent time working with Indiana Soccer as a coaching education instructor and an ODP staff coach.

Prior to joining our staff, he served as Director of Coaching (IYSA, Brownsburg Soccer League, Fusion Soccer Academy.) He was the Head Coach at Brownsburg High School - boys, Heritage Christian - Girls, and Westfield HS – Girls. He also spent time in the college ranks as the Head Coach at Hanover College and as an Assistant Coach at the University of Indianapolis. Chad has a Bachelor of Arts from Northwestern College.

Abbie Renaker

Abbie has ten years of club soccer coaching experience including five years at Dynamo FC. She has coached girls teams U-9 through U-17. Abbie currently holds a US Soccer National "D" license and will complete the US Soccer National "Youth" course this July.
