Scholarship Application

West Carroll Recreation Council is now accepting applications for one scholarship in the amount of \$1,000.00. The purpose of this scholarship is to reward a high school senior who has actively participated and/or volunteered in West Carroll Recreation Council programs.

Students must meet the eligibility requirements below to receive consideration.

Qualifications to Determine Eligibility for Scholarship

1. Applicant must be a senior.
2. Applicant must have been a participant or volunteer in West Carroll Recreation programs for a minimum of 3 years beginning with the 5th grade.
3. Applicant must submit a certified copy of their high school transcript demonstrating a cumulative minimum weighted GPA of 3.5 or higher.
4. Applicant shall demonstrate their intent to become a student in a program offered by an organization that has been accredited for that purpose by a state educational authority.
5. Applicant shall submit a complete scholarship application.

Application Procedures

Applicants shall submit the following to the West Carroll Recreation Council as detailed below:

1. Completed Scholarship Application
2. Certified High School Transcript
3. 250 to 500 Word Essay

The WCRC will accept applications beginning April 1st; however all submissions must be postmarked by April 30th.

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Essay Guidelines:

“How has participation and/or volunteering in the West Carroll Recreation programs prepared you for the future?”

Focus your essay on your academic achievement, civic involvement, leadership activities and positions you have held in youth sports. You may use all or some of the suggested topics below to develop your essay. Your essay shall be limited to 250 to 500 words.

1. Leadership/Group Contributions: Describe examples of your leadership experience and share how you have significantly influenced others, helped resolve disputes, or contributed to group efforts over time. Consider responsibilities you have taken for initiatives taken in or out of school.
2. Community Service: Explain what you have done to make your community a better place to live. Give examples of specific projects in which you have been involved over time.
3. Goals/Task Commitment: Articulate the goals you have established for yourself and your efforts to accomplish these. Give at least one specific example that demonstrates your work ethic/diligence.

Format

Your essay shall be typed, double-spaced and submitted on 8-1/2” x 11” white paper. The font shall be Times New Roman, size 12.
