

Parents Code of Conduct

Parents must conduct themselves properly at all times, on and off of the soccer field while representing Dynamo Soccer Club. Inflammatory language, profane remarks or gestures, derogatory remarks regarding gender, race, religion or country of origin will not be tolerated.



Parents Should Always:

- Stay on the spectators' side before, during, and after games. Once the player arrives at the field for the game he/she is under the direction of the coach.
- Help your child focus on performance and not the result. Winning is not everything.
- Wait on the spectators' side after the game. Players will dress on the sidelines (change jerseys and shoes) and then come across the field to the parents.
- Applaud good play by either team.
- Understand that players, coaches, and referees learn by making mistakes.
- Talk to the team manager as soon as they have a concern or question.
- Cheer in the past tense for good play.
- Encourage your child to speak with their coach. If your child is having difficulties in training or games, have them talk directly with your coach. This form of "responsibility taking" is part of becoming a mature person.

Parents Should Not:

- Approach the coach after a game.
- Coach or shout instructions from the sideline. This distracts players and prevents them from hearing their coach's instructions and making their own decisions.
- Criticize players, referees, or coaches.
- Criticize the opponents, their parents, or their club officials.
- Enter the field of play.

Please remember that the game is for the children. It is not for the glory of the coach, manager, or parents.
