In accepting a roster position on a Dynamo SC traveling soccer team, players and their families acknowledge that they are now part of a competitive traveling soccer program that wins and loses as a team, not as individuals. Winning teams, in any field of competition, have much in common. These teams are organized, disciplined, unified in purpose and focused. They exhibit camaraderie both on and off the field, are selfless, driven, and respectful. It is with this in the mind that the following guidelines are set forth:

Players Should Always:

- Respect their teammates regardless of circumstance, seeking greatly to encourage rather than reprimand.
- Play fair and behave in a professional and ethical manner both on and off the field regardless of any actual or perceived transgressions by opposing teams or officials.
- Be encouraged to practice at home as often as possible.
- Always give 100% effort in practice and games.
- Attend all practices, games, tournaments and other events their respective teams partake in.
- Win with grace, lose with grace and learn from both!

Players Should Not

- Use obscene or threatening language with anybody.
- Directly address an opposing coach or supporter during a game.
- Speak directly to the referee for any other purpose than to respectfully obtain instruction.
- Intentionally attempt to cause injury.
- Arrive late for any team games / practices or events.
