

PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

As a parent/guardian with a child or children in Villarreal Nebraska Academy, I understand that I represent the club whenever I attend a Villarreal Nebraska Academy event and that my actions have an impact on the image of the club and development of its players. I understand and agree to the following statements, and I take responsibility for ensuring that guests and/or friends with whom I am attending an event uphold the intent of this code of conduct. I understand and agree that a failure to abide by this code of conduct can result in a suspension or expulsion from Villarreal Nebraska Academy for parents and/or players.

1. I understand that the mission of Villarreal Nebraska Academy is to develop well-rounded soccer players and that games are used to further that development. I understand that this mission is given a higher priority than winning games. I will support this mission with my words and actions.
2. I will learn the laws of the game and the applicable rules for each game or event. I understand that the better I understand the laws and rules, the more enjoyable the game will be.
3. I understand that my demeanor both on and off the field is a reflection of the club. Poor sportsmanship and inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated. I agree to behave in an appropriate manner as determined by Villarreal Nebraska Academy Club at its discretion.
4. It is my responsibility to ensure that my child arrive at all events, including training and games, at the required time.
5. I will never use threats, physical force, or obscene/abusive language toward any coach, player, spectator, or referee.
6. I will not speak or gesture to any referee in a negative manner, both during and after any game. I will respect the decisions made by each referee, even if I disagree with them.
7. I will refrain from giving instructions to players during games, as I understand that my instructions may be either contrary to or distracting from the instructions of our coaches. I will cheer good plays by both teams.
8. I will never ridicule or yell at any player. This includes my own child, other Villarreal Nebraska Academy players, and opposing players.
9. I will address concerns with any coaches, club staff, or board members in a calm and respectful manner. All concerns related to a specific incident will be addressed no sooner than 24 hours after the time of the incident in order to allow for emotions to recede and ensure productive dialogue.
10. I will refrain from publicly discussing on social media, including, but not limited to, Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, and Snapchat, any grievance I may have concerning any aspect of Villarreal Nebraska Academy Club. These grievances or concerns will be addressed pursuant to and in accordance with paragraph 9 above.
11. I understand that during a game, I am not allowed onto the field of play, nor am I allowed to watch the game from behind the goal line. This also pertains to instances in which a player is injured on the field. In those instances, the referee will assess the injury and will either summon the coach or will resume play. I will not enter the field of play unless authorized by the referee or coach.
12. I will not negatively impact other player's or family's perceptions of the mission, the process or have a negative impact membership or teams in any way. The mission is a process and takes time, patience and an understanding.
13. I will remain on the opposite side of the field as the teams before, during, and after each game.

PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

As a player in Villarreal Nebraska Academy, I understand that I represent that the club whenever I attend a Villarreal Nebraska Academy event and that my actions have an impact on the image of the club. I understand and agree to the following statements. I understand and agree that a failure to abide by this code of conduct can result in a suspension or expulsion from Villarreal Nebraska Academy.

1. I understand that the mission of Villarreal Nebraska Academy is to develop well-rounded soccer players and that games are used to further that development. I understand that this mission is given a higher priority than winning games. I will support this mission with my words, actions, and effort.
2. I will learn the laws of the game and the applicable rules for each game or event. I understand that the better I understand the laws and rules, the more enjoyable the game will be.
3. I understand that my demeanor both on and off the field is a reflection of the club. Poor sportsmanship and inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated. I agree to behave in an appropriate manner as determined by Villarreal Nebraska Academy Club at its discretion.
4. It is my responsibility to ensure that I arrive at all events at the required time and that I am prepared with all proper gear (i.e. all uniform pieces, shin guards, shoes, ball, and water bottle).
5. I will play the game fairly and will not engage in actions intended to intentionally harm another player.
6. I will never use threats, physical force, or obscene/abusive language toward any coach, player, spectator, or referee.
7. I will not speak or gesture to any referee in a negative manner, both during and after any game. I will respect the decisions made by each referee, even if I disagree with them.
8. I will provide my coach with respect. I will listen to my coach and follow through on the instructions that are given to me.
9. I will never ridicule or yell at any player, including my teammates.
10. I will not use alcohol or illegal drugs.
11. I will address concerns with any coaches, club staff, board members, or spectators in a calm and respectful manner. All concerns related to a specific incident will be addressed no sooner than 24 hours after the time of the incident in order to allow for emotions to recede and ensure productive dialogue.
12. I will refrain from publicly discussing on social media, including, but not limited to, Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, and Snapchat, any grievance I may have concerning any aspect of Villarreal Nebraska Academy Club. These grievances or concerns will be addressed pursuant to and in accordance with paragraph 11 above.
13. I will remain with my team before, during, and after each game, until I am dismissed by my coach.
14. I will maintain a positive attitude and work hard to develop my skills

Waiver, Release of Liability & Concussion Policy

I consent to voluntarily participate in a baseline concussion testing program in order to measure my baseline score. I hereby state that to the best of my knowledge, I have no medical, mental, or physical conditions that may restrict me from completing a concussion test. I understand that the information provided by testing is of a general nature and does not represent medical advice, medical analysis, medical diagnosis, or prescription for medical treatment.

Once the baseline data is collected, it can help detection of possible concussion or traumatic brain injury at an event. It provides information for the parent and/or coach, staff or volunteer to consider when deciding whether to remove a participant from play. In instances in which a test is given to my child/participant and the results do not seem to indicate

an injury, I agree to make the decision whether to send my participant back into play, or if I am not present, I allow the coach, staff or volunteer to make the decision. In instances in which a test is given and the results indicate the possibility of an injury, I agree that my participant will be removed from play and that I will obtain written medical clearance prior to participating in any athletic training, practices, or events. I also agree to have my child/ participant evaluated by a physician if he/she develops any signs or symptoms of a concussion, regardless of the results of any sideline testing.

I understand that the coaches and/or volunteers that administer the tests are not medical personnel and are not acting in that capacity.

I agree that Nebraska Sports Center, Star City Futsal or it's other d.b.a.'s, including its organizations, directors, offices, sponsors, employees, agents, successors, and assigns may, but have no duty to, provide me customary medical assistance, transportation, and emergency medical services. I understand and agree that any time an individual is suspected of sustaining a traumatic brain injury or concussion, the individual should immediately seek the advice of a qualified and trained health care provider and should be monitored closely for the emergency of any signs and symptoms of an injury.

I hereby take the following actions for myself and my legal guardians, executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors, and assigns: a) I WAIVE, RELEASE AND DISCHARGE from claims or liabilities for death or personal injury or damages of any kind which arise out of or are related to my child's or my participant's participation with any and all staff or employees of Nebraska Sports Center dba Star City Futsal or other dba, all sponsors, and the trustees, officers, representatives, and agents of the above; b) I AGREE NOT TO SUE any of the persons or entities mentioned above for any of the claims or liabilities that I have waived, released, or discharged herein; and c) I INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS the persons and entities mentioned above from any claims or liabilities assessed against them as a result of my actions.

I HAVE READ THIS WAIVER, RELEASE OF LIABILITY, AND CONCUSSION POLICY AND I VERIFY THAT FULLY AGREE TO, UNDERSTAND, AND ACCEPT ALL OF ITS TERMS AND CONDITIONS.

Financial Policy

Membership Programs including YellowTEAM, GroguetTEAM, Select, Elite, Ultra Programs.

Program costs have 2 options for payments.

Option 1, can be paid in full at the time of program registration.

Option 2, Deposit Due with program registration all fees collected at time of registration are nonrefundable, as those fees are collected for immediate use for league, tournament and player registration. The remaining balance can be divided into monthly payments as indicated at time of registration per the payment plan indicated. Installment fees are collected when the payment plan option is selected. NOTE, monthly payments are not monthly fees, membership fees are for the year.

Classes, Services, Event Registrations including Submarine Classes, Submarine League, Optional Additional Events, Camps, Clinic. These program costs have 1 option for payments. Option 1 can be paid in full at the time of program registration. At times Option 2 Deposit with a payment plan, may be used. Installment fees are collected when the payment plan option is selected. NOTE, monthly payments are not monthly fees, membership fees are for the year.

Additional information

1. Deposit due with program registration is nonrefundable.
2. Monthly payment amounts. Each registration has a differing monthly payment plan. Please refer to your registration payment plan. All monthly payments must be made on time or late fees and finance

charges may be applied in addition. Players may become ineligible to participate until payments are in good standing. Payment plans have installment, convenience, processing fees.

3. The length of a payment plan is based on the number of months of service. Partial Year programs have shorter payment plan lengths. For Example, If Fall Only program will likely have a 4 month plan due in Aug, Sept, Oct, Nov. If Fall and Winter program will likely have a 7 month plan due in Aug, Sept, Oct, Nov, Dec, Jan, Feb. If Full Year program will likely have a 9 month plan due in Aug, Sept, Oct, Nov, Dec, Jan, Feb, Mar, Apr or 10 month plan would include May.

NOTE, regardless of payment method including, credit card, debit card, check, cash etc. the registration portal charges a user service fee for program payments per their policies. Those charges are not related to any amounts or policies under our control and are non-refundable and are not waived.

REFUNDS

1. Registration for membership programs have a non-refundable administrative fee of \$200, calculated at the time of refund request.
2. Additional nonrefundable fees will include any fees associated with programs, player registration, league registration, tournament registration, bank fees, installment fees, convenience fees and other expenses already paid on behalf of the player, prior to the request for a refund and or release.
3. The per season fee if participating in a year long program, is defined as the prorated number of training sessions of the season.
4. Tournament fees and League fees are nonrefundable once the team is registered for them. Any fees collected for competitions, that are not used, are refundable less any bank fees, processing fees, service fees.
5. If a refund is requested prior to the first training session, and prior to team and player registration, a full refund of the per season fee, minus the \$200 administrative fee, will be issued.
6. After the first training session of the season, or if team and player registration has occurred, no refunds will be issued for that season.
7. Unforeseen Disruptions, included but not limited to pandemics, natural disasters, etc. No Refund of Program Fees, Members make a yearly commitment to Membership Fees which sets the budget and contractual obligations of VNA. If contractual obligations are forgiven, then program fees may also be refunded.
8. The only exceptions are documented cases in which the player is moving 50 or more miles from Lincoln or Omaha, or the player has a season ending injury or illness, or when special circumstances are approved by management and or Board of Directors.

Examples for Member Program Refund ProRated Calculations.

1. YellowTEAM Program 38 sessions. Fall Season 1x per week training for 12 weeks is 12 sessions, Winter Season 1x per week training for 14 weeks is 14 sessions, Spring Season 1x per week training for 12 weeks is 12 sessions

2. GroguetTEAM Program 50 sessions. Fall Season 1x per week training for 12 weeks is 12 sessions, Winter Season 1x per week training for 14 weeks is 14 sessions, Spring Season 2x per week training for 12 weeks is 24 sessions
3. Select Program 62 sessions. Fall Season 2x per week training for 12 weeks is 24 sessions, Winter Season 1x per week training for 14 weeks is 14 sessions, Spring Season 2x per week training for 12 weeks is 24 sessions
4. Elite and Ultra Program: 86 sessions. Fall Season 3x per week training for 12 weeks is 36 sessions, Winter Season 1x per week training for 14 weeks is 14 sessions, Spring Season 3x per week training for 12 weeks is 36 sessions. NOTE, Elite and Ultra Program refer to the program details. Each team may vary slightly.

As Needed: The Summer Season may be included for unforeseen programming needs dictate. 1x per week training as needed or Summer Camp, Clinic Programming.
