

## USCAA Girls 10U Softball Announcement

This year, the USCAA will have up to 6 softball teams participating in a 10U in-house league. All games will be played against other USC teams and all games will be played in USC. The league will use its best efforts to ensure that the teams are equally matched. The focus of the league will be on skill development, learning the game of softball and having fun.

In addition to the in-house teams, the USCAA will be entering a 10U team into the Greater Pittsburgh Girls Softball League (“GPGSL”). This is a recreational league, but the teams are typically very skilled and often roster competitive club players. The USC GPGSL team will travel to other local communities for away games, but the travel should be limited to the South Hills and surrounding areas. The USC GPGSL team will be comprised of 12 - 14 players. Players must be no older than 10 years of age as of January 1, 2019 (born 2008 or later). USC GPGSL players will be expected to play for their in-house team and also play for the USC GPGSL team - schedule permitting. In the event of a conflict, USC GPGSL players will play for the GPGSL team. The GPGSL season runs from April 1 - July 31. The USC GPGSL team will also enter a summer tournament. There is no additional charge to play on the USC GPGSL team.

If your daughter would like to play for the USC GPGSL team, she must attend one of the following try out sessions:

Saturday, March 9, 2019      3:00 -5:00 PM Eisenhower Gym

Thursday, March 14, 2019      6:30 - 8:30 PM Eisenhower Gym

Girls should bring a bat, glove, facemask and helmet with a full cage to try outs. Girls should wear tennis shoes - no spikes.

The tryouts will be judged by experienced impartial evaluators who will not have daughters on the team.
