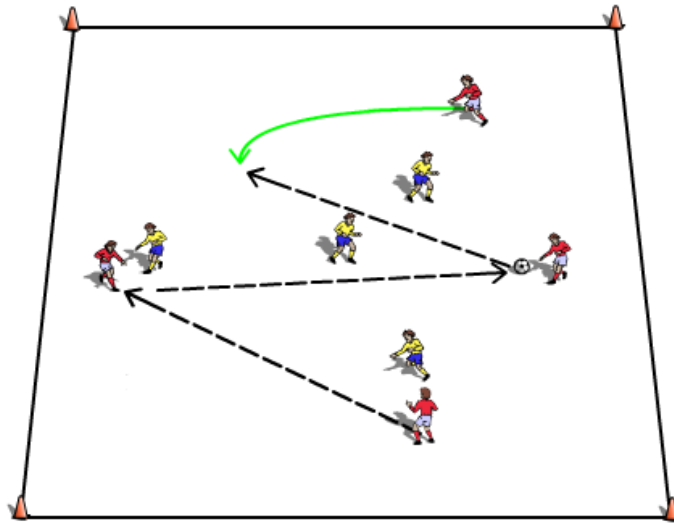

GAME 4: Possession Through Passing



Game Description

The 4 v 4 is set out as above with the players encouraged to use the full area of the pitch incorporating length, width and depth. Players are encouraged to keep possession of the ball. A point can be scored when there is a set number of passes achieved, and determined, by the coach dependent on ability levels of players.

Objectives

Players are encouraged to use a variety of passing and control techniques to keep possession of the ball. The players should move to receive a pass and look to create a passing line for the player on the ball. The players not in possession of the ball should either move to receive a pass or create space for a team mate to receive the ball.

Coaching Points

Attacking

- Weight of the pas
- Encourage when to pass
- Select correct passing technique (i.e. Chipped, Driven, etc.)
- Create angles for player in possession of the ball

Defending

- Try to win the ball back quickly
- Help the defending player by offering cover in space behind
- Short & Narrow Diamond shape
- Work together to deny space
