Hoop Generation Camp Covid-19 Guidelines

At Hoop Generation, we are 100% committed to providing you with an amazing experience through our high-quality basketball camps. Even though some circumstances have changed, our commitment to you has not. We wanted to share with you the steps we have taken to provide you with a worry-free experience and ask that you do your part in helping us keep everyone safe and healthy.

PLEASE READ THROUGH THESE GUIDELINES FULLY BEFORE ARRIVING AT CAMP:

Hoop Generation Staff

- All camp staff will be screened at check-in on the day of the event
- All Camps will have a 1:10 Coach to Camper Ratio

Coaches

- Coaches will hand sanitize during each 30 minute break
- Coaches will wear face and nose masks when they are in a proximity of less than 6 feet away of all campers

Players

- When not scrimmaging, players will be required to maintain CDC guidelines of 6ft. Social Distancing on the sideline when not in the game
- Players must bring their own basketballs and no sharing will be allowed.
- Prior to camp, each participant must write their own names on their basketball to prevent the spread of Covid-19.
- Players must bring their own water and drink only from their personal receptacle
- Players must be able to shoot on a 10ft Hoop
- **Players will be required to bring their own hand sanitizer and sanitize every 30 minutes and every break which will be monitored by the Hoop Generation Staff**

Spectators

- Spectators will be required to view the game from a designated area.
- Spectators will be required to maintain CDC guidelines of 6ft. Social Distancing
- Spectators may NOT congregate on the player sideline
- Spectators are encouraged to wear a nose and face covering
- Spectators may watch from their cars

Training/Game Modifications

- Players will be required to stay in their designated sideline area and maintain 6ft. social distance when not in the game
- No Pre or Post game high fives or hand shakes, fist bumps will be encouraged
- No team huddles that bring the players closer than 6ft.
- Fouls/unnecessary contact will be looked at heavily throughout playing - there will be at least 1 coaching staff member present to referee the games to keep player physical contact limited. If a player cannot stop fouling the opposing player, he/she will be asked to sit out for the possession or at extreme levels asked not to return into the game.
- Basketballs will be sanitized prior to the start of the game and after each quarter
