Teams may qualify for a National tournament which would incur small additional costs.</li><li>● 12U/14U/16U: 2 game nights per week in the West Metro (May-early July). 3 weekend tournaments in the Metro area, plus Qualifier and State tournaments. Teams may qualify for a National tournament which would incur small additional costs.</li></ul>
<p><b>Machine Pitch (8U)</b></p> <p>\$150– (for girls born 1/1/2009 to 12/31/2010)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● 8U games start mid May and games are once a week for 8 weeks. One weekend tournament plus the state tournament.</li><li>● Girls continue to advance their softball skills through practice and game settings. The goal is to get kids playing short games, learn how to play the games properly, and enjoy the sport.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● 10U/12U Hopkins Royals Rampage Tournament June 2-3</li><li>● 14U/16U Royal Rampage Tournament June 22-23.</li><li>● All families help out with running the Royal Rampage which is a fundraiser for the organization. Bring \$100 deposit to evaluation day, voided upon fulfilling this obligation.</li></ul>
<p><b>Recreational Program</b></p> <p>\$155 - D5 – Grades 7-12</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Practice starts in late-April with games May-July.</li><li>● 1-2 games per week in West Metro area.</li><li>● End of season tournament in early July.</li><li>● Uniform top included.*</li><li>● Recreational teams are for the older girls who like the challenge of fastpitch softball while participating in other activities during the summer. This is primarily for non-high school players.</li></ul>
