Daryl Doran Joins Missouri Thorns and FC Missouri

Doran is a native to the St. Louis area, having attended Christian Brothers College High School and St. Louis University before joining the St. Louis Steamers (MISL team) after their second attempt to draft him. Most of Doran's professional indoor soccer career took place in St. Louis, as well as his coaching career, which began while he was still an active player for the St. Louis Ambush in 1999.
