Secretary's report was read, motion to accept Jeff Cummins, second Jim Rohne

Treasurer – Main account \$15,745.85 and Concession account \$707.95 for a total of \$16,453.80. Main expenses this month were \$370 for a 25 gallon sprayer, \$346 for tractor parts, and \$275 in labor to Mike Gullet for tractor repairs and \$600 in gas for the mower.
