Spring Picture Day is Tuesday May 9th at Copeland Middle School. Pictures are for Rec and Rockaway Valley. Individual pictures can be taken if a team opts to not have a team picture.

Rec medals will be ordered in the near future. Coaches will receive them when they pick up their team's pictures.

RTSA Day at Tri-County Fair is Saturday June 17th from 3pm to 11pm. Advanced price vouchers cost \$20 each, but are worth \$25. They are used to purchase sheets of tickets. We will run a dunk tank. We need 16 volunteers to be dunked (30 minute shifts) and 32 volunteers to collect money (1 hour shifts of 2 people). Thursday June 15th & Sunday June 18th- vouchers can be used to buy unlimited ride bands with an additional \$5.

May add Thursday's to Norway Game schedules.

Travel Tryouts start tomorrow, 4/24 and will run over 2 weeks. Each age/gender has a night each week. Cheshire will be primary evaluator. If there is a rainout, tryout is moved to the Friday of the same week. Players trying up 2 years will be in top third of the team size.

Player trying up 1 year that are in grade of older age then there is no impact. If a child is grade below age and trying up a year will need to be in top half.

Coaches should be at tryout. Goal is to announce right after Memorial Day weekend.

All MHRD residents are welcome to try out for Travel.

Practice for travel is available at Hudsonia WITHOUT Trainers during Travel Evaluations.

For international Recreation soccer for the Fall, considering moving to co-ed to be in line with Rockaway Valley. Will be finalized prior to opening

Travel Director's Report (TravelDirector@rtsa.org) – Rick Suntag

The season has started slowly due to closed fields and April school breaks.

Rockaway Valley started 2 weeks late and has scheduled midweek games to make up for it - 14 so far scheduled for Norway

We still have 12 PCNs to schedule, plus a few league cup games

We have a 2 week freeze on using Norway midweek due to tryouts

The above accounts for 26 midweek game slots plus another 12 for the 2 weeks of tryouts. There are only a total of 40 midweek game slots between now and the end of the season. 21 already have games scheduled or are being held for potential games. There's only 19 slots left to work with. A rainout on a busy Sunday will put us over the limit.

Bottom line - Game time field space is at a premium. Get your games scheduled. Try to play them as early as possible / don't wait until June. Teams have been slow to schedule their PCNs - We played very few midweek games in April / your PCNs are still unscheduled and now teams may end up being forced to play home games away because of this.

Note: I expect all PCNs to be scheduled by the end of April - you've had over a month and some teams have put in little to no effort to get these scheduled. If your PCNs not scheduled at that point, I expect an email from you with detailed reasons why the opponent will not accept any of the multiple dates you have been offering over the past month. Barring that, I will offer the game to the opponent to play on their field to free up our fields for teams that have made an effort to get their games played.

I am hoping that next season, PCNs are all scheduled by 2 weeks into the season. There's zero excuse to go beyond that point.
