

# SLYSI Rules

- You will be assigned a practice schedule. All teams are responsible for watering and raking the field after each of your practices. Please make sure your coordinator knows if you will NOT use the slot. If you practice elsewhere please ensure you are aware of SLYSI/Parish insurance policy. (Coverage is only for Parish owned property)
- Each team is responsible for getting a sponsor. Please call Sara Jones for information on this.
- It is the responsibility of the home team to have a scorekeeper & scoreboard operator. We are only asking them to keep up with the score and the outs. Please let your parents know now that you will need someone to help with this on all Home assigned games.
- We are also asking the parents to help work concessions. We will be creating a team schedule assigning days that your team will be responsible to work. We feel that this will get more parents involved and remind them of why we are here. If any of your parents are interested in working additional days, please have them call Bet Edney 278-3050 and she will schedule them for whenever they want to work.
- NO OUTSIDE FOOD OR DRINKS are allowed in the park. The only exception is that players may have one water bottle or sports drink. If they are seen with them, we will ask them to throw it away. We will offer team snow cones at a discounted price if they are interested.
- PLEASE make sure that your dugouts are clean before you leave.
- If you are the visiting team it is your responsibility to rake & water the field once your game is complete.
- If you need anything or have any problems, contact your league coordinator.
- All Coaches need to be certified and have taken the concussion course.
- No cursing will be tolerated, and no belligerent arguing with the umpires will be tolerated. An ejection results in a suspension of 1 game at minimum and is subject to further penalty after a meeting of the board to determine the facts. Coaches will be held accountable for all parent action and will be subject to ejection from the game.
- Ensure that all understand that the Code of Conduct applies to everyone in attendance to our park.

We will always have a board member on duty in a green shirt so if you need something ASAP, you will be able to find them or you can go to the concession to ask.
